Dear Families of Christ King Parish School,

Thank you for committing to our community of discipleship at Christ King Parish School. Please read this tuition agreement carefully. It clarifies the benefits and expectations of families who entrust their students to the care of our parish school.

### "What Do I Get?"

Christ King Parish School commits to providing a faith-based education to your children. We know our students, we love our students, and we prepare them for high school and heaven.

### "What Do I Give?"

We hope you will feel called to give sacrificially, offering your time, talent, and treasure in ways that make a difference to your family. Some people tell us they don't know where to start, though, so consider a minimum contribution in the following areas (there is no maximum!):

- Time: Several hours a month--this might come in the form of planning and working at one major parish or school event and helping with 10-20 smaller opportunities (about 1-2 a month), such as recess duty, hospitality at weekend Mass, field trip supervision, etc.
- Talent: You are a gift! Please communicate with Terri Hawk and the Parent Engagement committee to discern where your particular strengths might shine in areas needed by the parish and school.
- Treasure: Christ King Parish considers the school part of its spiritual mission and strives to keep tuition affordable. Tuition charged is a fraction of the actual cost to educate children. Consistent parish stewardship heavily subsidizes the gap between tuition and the actual school operating costs. Donating to the parish should be a financial priority for each parish family, a critical monthly line item in the family budget. Annually we ask families to pray on what they can tithe (scripture states 10%) and commit via parish pledge card.

(Part of what it means to be an "active parishioner" is donating to Christ King Parish. Thus, in recognition of that extra financial stewardship, those who are active parishioners are eligible for a reduced tuition rate.)

### "Do I Belong?"

Christ King Parish School nurtures our children's growth in the Catholic faith by teaching them to accept and respect Jesus in everyone they meet within an environment that cultivates academic excellence, encourages service to others, fosters leadership, and allows all students to develop their God-given talents. That mission promises spiritual, academic, and personal growth in a Christian community. This community includes you. Your own spiritual growth is a priority, and we welcome you to participate in at-home prayer, small group opportunities in the parish and school, and large group events. Most importantly, attending Mass every weekend helps us all belong to God and one another.

### "How Can We Grow?"

Check out our current parish and school offerings (on the attached page) and commit to at least two opportunities. Pay attention to how you and your family members grow as you embrace spiritual, social, and educational moments at home and in the parish community. The Lord is king; let the earth rejoice!
